Ambulances and Support Vehicles for Ukraine

We have been working in Ukraine and delivering aid there since 1991. Two and a half years since the invasion, our teams on the ground are still working tirelessly to provide practical, spiritual and pastoral support. One of the continuing practical needs is for emergency vehicles to save the lives of civilians and soldiers.

Right is one of the fully functioning ambulances we have sent, being prepared at our warehouse. It is loaded with stretchers, medical equipment and consumables. Thank you very much to everyone who has kindly donated in any way to make this possible.

How have International Aid Trust helped those affected by the war in Ukraine?

Having worked in Ukraine for over thirty years, when the war began we were very well placed to get aid and funding through quickly to support our Ukraine staff, volunteers and churches. This enabled them to provide practical and spiritual support to people in need immediately.

Since the invasion of Ukraine in February 2022 we have been sending articulated lorries full of vital aid, generously donated in the UK. This aid weighs over 765 tonnes in total and has a financial value of £15.75 million.



From the very start of the war we have also been funding vehicles, firstly vans and trailers for aid distribution and then as the need became clear, we began to source and to send ambulances and 4x4 pickups for emergency transport.

The picture left shows one of the ambulances

being handed over to Fastov Regional Hospital in August 2023, and some of the medical equipment and supplies that were sent in it. Over twenty vehicles have been provided so far, some bought in Ukraine and some sent from the UK.

What is the current need for vehicles in Ukraine?

The urgent need is for emergency vehicles for the Ukrainian National Guard to use in front line areas.

Colonel Sergii says “The ambulances are essential for the first ten minutes after someone is injured in our current circumstances. Now we also need more 4x4 pickups that can drive fast on bad roads, to get the injured to the ambulances and then when stabilised, the ambulances can get them to the hospital.” Right is Keith with two of the 4x4 pickups being prepared to go to Ukraine.

Ruslan then took the ambulance on the rest of it's journey, he says “thank you very much to everyone who has donated, the guys who received this

ambulance said it is a very good vehicle. It will help to evacuate injured soldiers and civilians. It came straight from England, filled to the top with drugs for the Intensive Care Unit, it went to the front line, to Zaphrozhye, one of the hottest areas of the war.”
