Where will your gift go?

If you leave a gift to International Aid Trust, you can guarantee that we will use your money with care. No matter what, your money will go towards:

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What kind of gifts can I leave?

A residuary gift – a share or percentage of your estate after other specific gifts have been made to friends and family.

A pecuniary gift – is a specific amount of money, however, it is worth bearing in mind the effects of inflation could mean that your gift could lose value over time and be less than you intended. You can ask your solicitor to index-link to safeguard its value.

A specific gift – which could be a particular item such as a personal possession, property or shares.
